When did you first come to the Blues?

I was influenced early in life by American gospel singers - Mahalia Jackson was a favourite and I always loved protest songs and songs that were big and bold. Songs that told a story and that you could move to.

Who are your favourite blues artists?

I love Beth Hart, she is a blues singer from North America, she covers some classics, but mainly does her own music. She is contemporary blues. Beth plays the piano and so her music is often very creative and certainly not straight 12 bars. She has

had a difficult life and she uses her music as a way of telling her story, looking for healing, for peace. I saw her in concert in Melbourne last year and on stage her energy was visceral, it was raw and real.




